

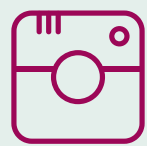

Nadia was born and raised in Los Angeles, California and has been performing, singing, and writing music since the age of seven. Nadia's current blending of genres Pop, Country and Folk/Blues style inspired by Brandi Carlile, Rachel Platten, Ray LaMontagne and Ed Sheeran has come through her years of experience in finding who she really is as an artist.

Nadia's desire to create music that truly affects people expanded as she grew as a person and a mother. Her commitment to telling her own story and be unapologetically authentic is what sets her apart. Coming to this place took some time. Nadia first broke into the music industry at 13 years old with her first recording contract with Producer Billy Steinburg (The Bangles). As a young singer/songwriter Nadia performed with legends like Taj Mahal and did backgrounds for James Ingram and Kenny Loggins.

She was on Broadway by the time she was 17 in Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat. During that time, she decided to move to New York for the prestigious CAP21 Program at Tisch at NYU (Graduates like Lady Gaga and Kristen Bell). She studied with esteemed vocal coaches Ralph Affoumado and Margie Balter.

Nadia then went on to record an EP with Producer Kevin Irving (Trax Records) in a Pop, Adult Contemporary style. She continued to write and perform across the country in cities such as Nashville, New Orleans, Los Angeles and New York. Nadia especially loved recording in New Orleans with producer Greg Barnhill and amazing musicians and artists including Shane Theroit, Jack Miele and Tony Hall.

In 2012 Nadia released her EP, A-Side, produced by David Baerwald (Sheryl Crow and Leann Rimes) and mixed by the amazing Niko Bolas at Capitol Records.

Nadia had her struggles in the business after a time in Nashville, prior to the ME TOO movement that took the joy out of music for her. She decided to take a break from the industry to then meet the love of her life and start a family.

After almost a decade-long break Nadia has returned to music to now do it the way she has always wanted to, with something to say and the willingness to be who she really is. After an original song placement in an upcoming series, Nadia is back in the business.

Now working with producer Lennon Leppart and vocal coach Dean Shepherd, Nadia has brought her music to a new level.

"There is something to be said for falling and getting back up, at any age. I'm not only doing this for myself, but to show my children that it is never too late to go after what you love." - Nadia
